 - *Identify the “right” students*

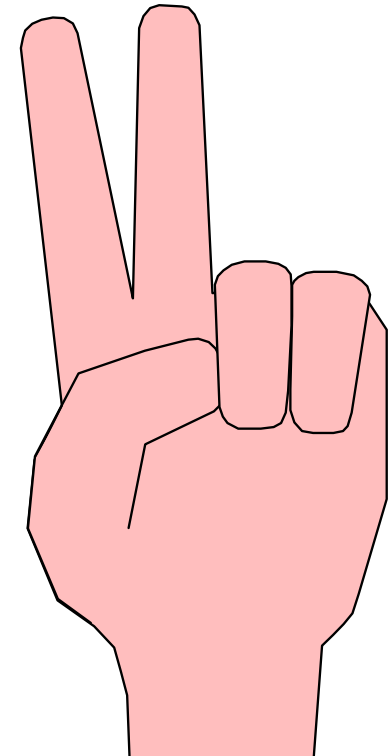

Condition 1

Administrative support

- *Understands 50/50 concept*
- *Infrastructure & resources in place*
- *Commitment to reduced class size*

Five Considerations

Getting the Program Going



Condition 2

Find the “right” facilitator

- *Not necessarily the tech. teacher*
- *Technology “with it”*
- *Facilitator, coach, mentor, model*

Condition 3

Provide the “right” training

- DoDEA summer workshop*
- Email & other electronic collaboration*

Condition 4

Identify the “right” students

- *Highly motivated & responsible*
- *Strong interest in learning technology*
- *Interest in education & teaching*
- *Strong writing & communication skills*

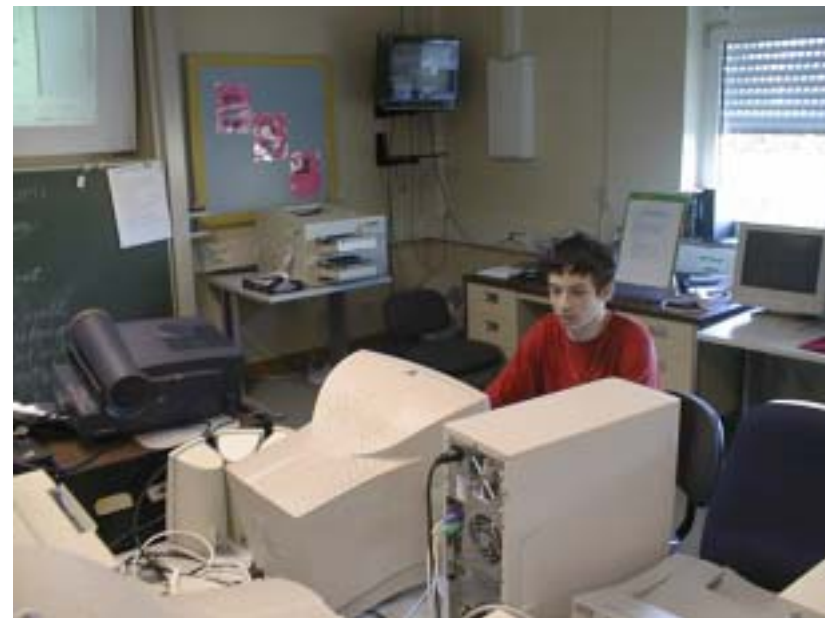
