# What is a WebQuest?

- A WebQuest is an **inquiry-oriented** activity in which most or all of the **information** used by learners is **drawn from the Web**.

# What is a WebQuest?

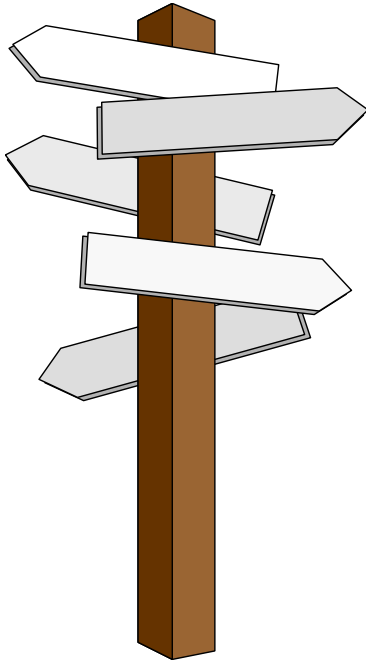
*(Continued)*

- WebQuests are designed to use learners' **time** well, to focus on using **information** rather than looking for it, and to support learners' **thinking** at the levels of analysis, synthesis and evaluation.

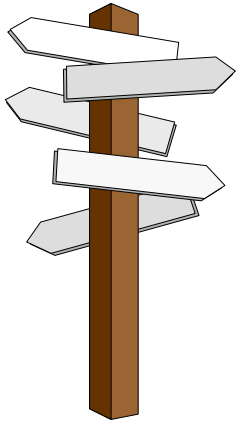

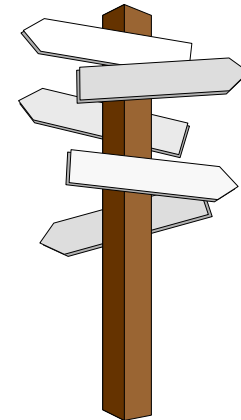
# Introduction

... to orient the learner to what is coming  
... to raise some interest in the learner



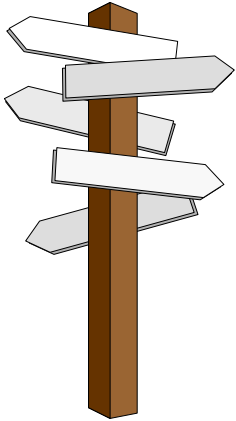
# Task

... a description of what the learner  
will have done at the end of the  
experience



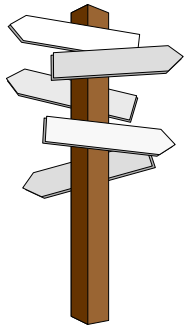
# Process

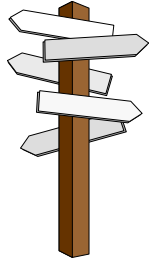
... teacher suggests the steps that the learner should go through in completing the task



# Resources

... a list of web pages which the instructor has located that will help the learner accomplish the task

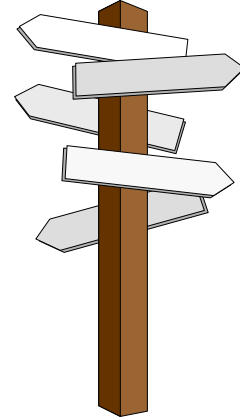




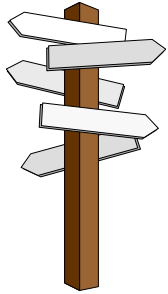
# Evaluation

... measure the results of learning

... often a rubric



# Conclusion

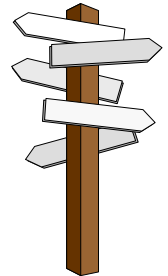


... summarize the experience

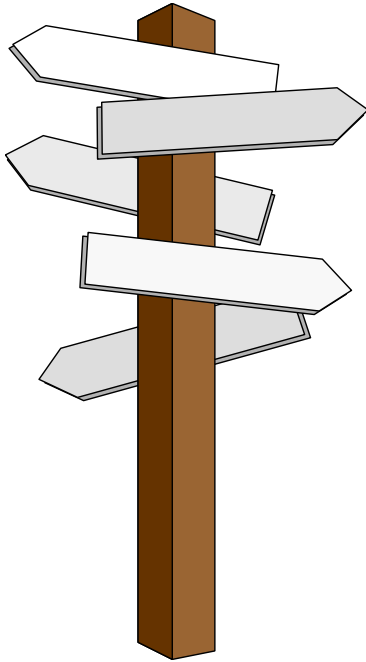
... reflection about the process
